



NOTICE OF VACANCY FOR COMMISSIONS/COMMITTEE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, pursuant to Ca. Gov Code § 54974, the following vacancies exist on the following legislative body in the City of Baldwin Park. The City is now accepting applications to fill scheduled vacancies on all Commissions.

Qualifications pursuant to BPMC § 32.11: (A) Commission members shall be qualified residents of the city at the time of their appointment and at all other times during their term and (B) Commission members shall not hold public office as an elected official at the time of their appointment or at any other time during their term.

The following vacancies exist on the following legislative body in the City of Baldwin Park:

Planning Commission - Meetings are held on the 2nd and 4th Wednesday of the month.

- Five (5) Planning Commission Seats Open.
- Term: Expires June 30, 2027

Recreation/Community Services Commission - Meetings are held on the 1st Monday of the month.

- Eight (8) Recreation/Community Services Commission Seats Open.
- Term: Seats Nos 1 -5 Expire June 30, 2027
 - Seat Nos. 6 – 8 (BPUSD High School Students): thru June 30, 2026
 - **Seat No. 6- Student from Baldwin Park high School**
 - **Seat No. 7- Student from Sierra Vista High School**
 - **Seat No. 8- Student from North Park High School**
- Act in an advisory capacity to the City Council with respect to the acquisition, development and maintenance of park, recreation and social service facilities in the city.
- **Students** interested in Seat Nos. 6, 7 and 8 must be over the age of 16 years and less than 19 years of age during their terms of office.

Personnel Commission - Meetings are held on an as-needed basis.

- Five (5) Personnel Commission Seats Open.
- Term: Expires June 30, 2027

Measure BP Stakeholders Oversight Committee (SOC) - Meetings are held on 1st Tuesday of the month.

- Three (3) SOC Seats Open.
- Term: Expires June 30, 2029

These seats have an essential role in the legislative process by acting as an advisory body to the City Council on all issues as well as functions as the decision-making body for a number of proposals.

Candidates must be age 18 years or older, a registered voter (except for Recreation & Community Services Student Candidates) and a resident of the City of Baldwin Park during their appointment and at all times during their term. All applicants must pass a background check. Furthermore, some Commission seats require successful completion of an Ethics Training course and submission of State mandated disclosure forms. Interested candidates can apply for this position by submitting an application to City Hall or email your applications to squinones@baldwinparkca.gov by June 30, 2025 or until filled.
